

Who can Join 4-H?

4-H is open to all youth in both rural and urban areas, along with any youth in 5yr Kindergarten through one year beyond high school graduation (grade 13) up to age 19 is eligible to join a 4-H club. 4-H is open to everyone regardless of race, color, sex, national origin, or handicap. Adults can become involved as volunteer leaders.
